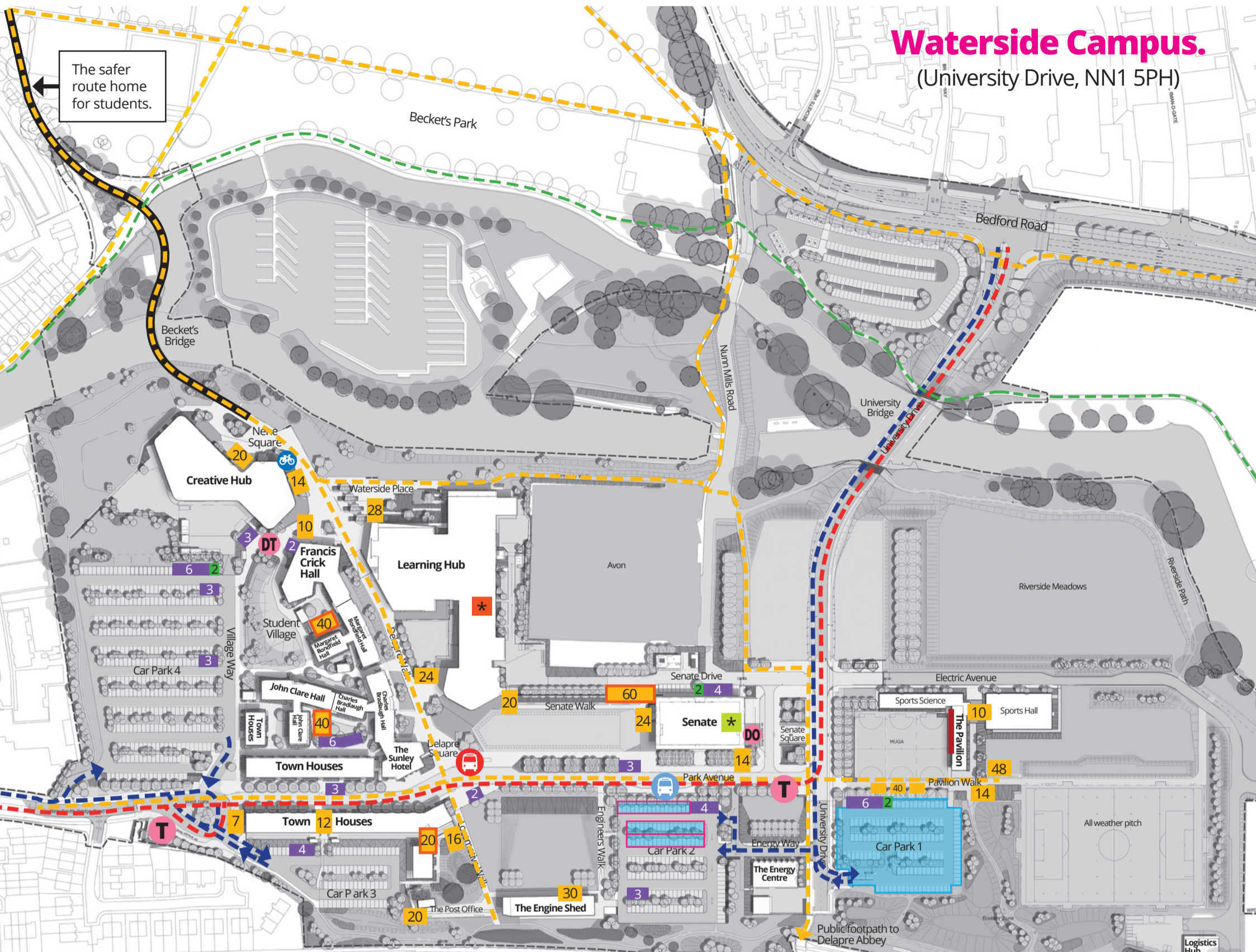


Waterside Campus.

A walk from the Logistics Hub to the Creative Hub is 0.5 miles via the footpaths, taking on average 10 minutes.

A few minutes' walk from the town centre, the Waterside Campus is located on the banks of the River Nene in Northampton's Enterprise Zone.

There is parking for staff and visitors at most university sites charged at £3 per day, however staff can take advantage of a discounted monthly rate. Blue Badge holders, motorbikes and mopeds can park in the designated areas free of charge.

The university's new **Park and Ride scheme**, just 2 miles from Waterside, has free parking and our Uno 18 bus is just £1 a day (Monday - Friday), or walk or cycle for free.

Coming by train? The station is only a 15-minute walk from Waterside, a quick bus ride (Uno 18) or a short cycle ride using one of the station's Cycle CoNNect hire bikes.

Waterside has its own **Cycle CoNNect** dock on campus; where staff, students and visitors will be able to dock their bike and/or rent a new bike by the hour for onward travel.

If you're **bringing your own bike** there is plenty of covered, racked and folding bike cycle storage alongside showers and the use of day lockers.

Want to purchase a new bike? The University has a tax-free cycle-to-work scheme for staff with Cycle Solutions.

From Waterside you can walk to: St John's Halls & House, the Podiatry Clinic, The Platform, The Innovation Centre, town centre, bus station and rail station in less than 15 minutes.

Getting around Northampton or between university sites couldn't be easier, we operate our own bus service, **Uno**, within the town with discounts for staff and students, including a free bus between Waterside and St. George's Avenue Monday – Friday. We have a new fleet of buses that all offer free Wi-Fi and USB charging points so you can stay online while on the move. Bus timetables can be found at: <http://unobus.info>

In addition, the university's new **Park and Ride scheme** from Edgar Mobbs Way, Sixfields, NN5 5JR, has free parking and our Uno 18 bus is just £1 a day (Monday - Friday) or walk or cycle for free.

If you're going to St. George's Avenue you can take the 18 to Marefair and then change to the free 20 bus at Sol Central.

Visitors can also use the park and ride and travel on the Uno 18 for £1.20 return – please visit the Security Cabin on site and sign out a visitor pass.

Cycle CoNnect have bike hire docking stations at the park and ride, Waterside, St George's Avenue and Boughton Green Road Halls: as well as across the town, where you'll be able to rent a bike by the hour for your journey.

If you want to cycle to work but often need a car for travel to meetings, you can make use of a **free pool car** to make at work travel (more details coming soon). Or you can claim back bus journeys and cycling expenses on your own personal bike at 20p per mile. For more information, visit the staff intranet travel pages.
