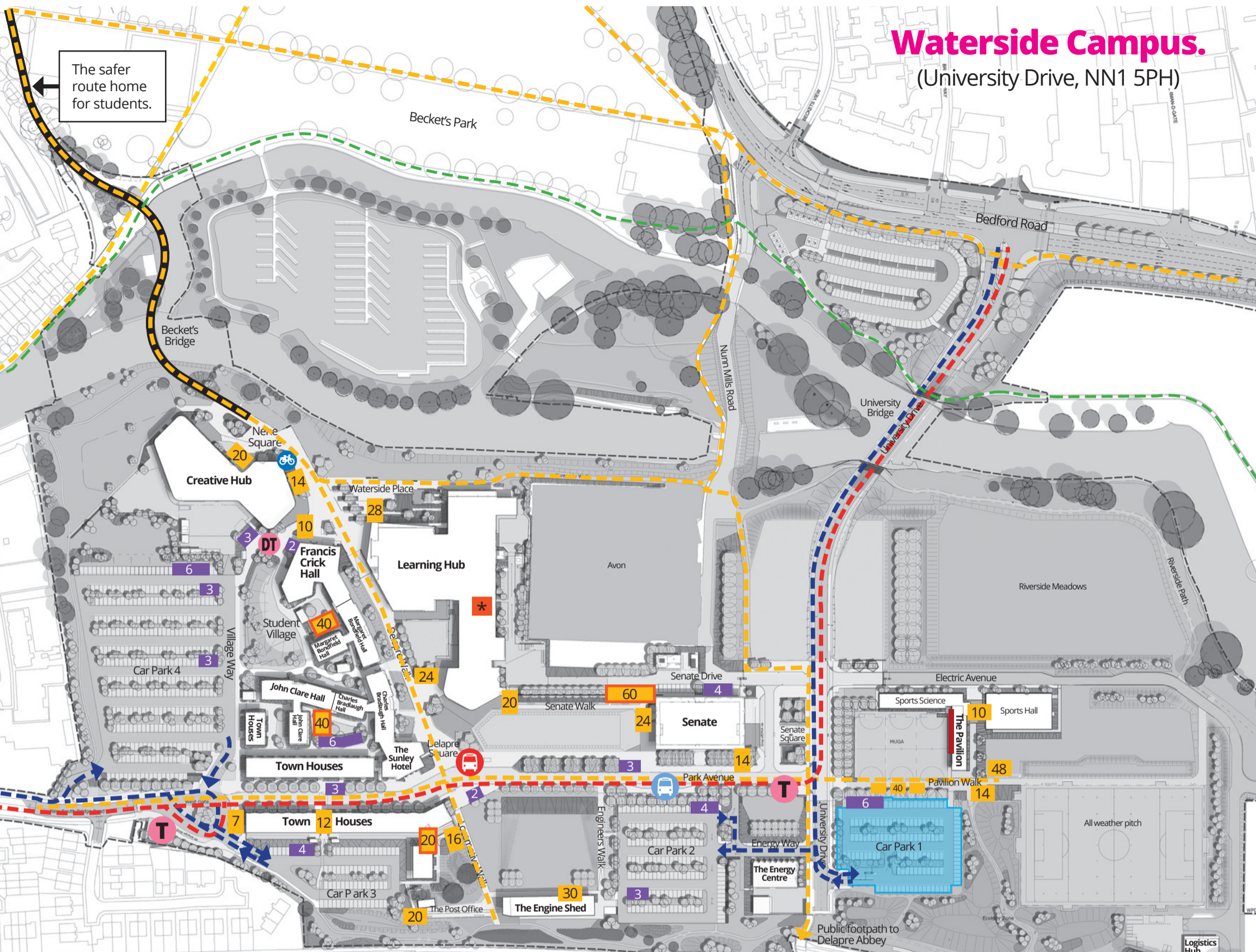

A walk from the Logistics Hub to the Creative Hub is 0.5 miles via the footpaths, taking on average 10 minutes.

A few minutes' walk from the town centre, the Waterside Campus is located on the banks of the River Nene in Northampton's Enterprise Zone. From Waterside you can walk to: St John's Halls & House, The Platform, bus station and two large supermarkets in less than 10 minutes.

Coming by train? No problem! The station is only a 15-minute walk from Waterside, or a short cycle ride using one of the station's **Cycle CoNnect hire bikes**, dock it at Waterside outside the Creative Hub.

If you're **bringing your own bike** there is plenty of covered and racked cycle storage alongside showers and the use of day lockers.

Need to drive? The University's **Park and Ride scheme** is just 2 miles away for easy access to the Waterside Campus. If you're a blue badge holder or registered with ASSIST you can apply for a permit for on-campus parking, see the ASSIST webpages for more information.

Commuting St. George's Avenue students can apply for the limited parking there for £1 per day, see the Student Hub car parking pages. (Student Hub -> About Un -> Facilities -> Travel & Transport)

Getting around Northampton or between university sites couldn't be easier, we operate our own bus service, **Uno**, within the town with discounts for students, including a **free** bus between Waterside and St. George's Avenue (inc. Bassett Lowke Halls) Monday – Friday. Students living at our Boughton Green Road Halls will benefit from **free** travel on the Uno 19 service to St. George's Avenue and Waterside Monday – Friday (full fare at weekends).

We have launched a new fleet of buses that all offer free Wi-Fi and USB charging points so you can stay online while on the move.

In addition, the University's **Park and Ride scheme** from Edgar Mobbs Way, Sixfields, NN5 5JR, links to Waterside, the Innovation Centre, the rail station and the town centre. You can park for free and grab one of our Uno 18 buses for £1 a day. If you're going to St. George's Avenue take the 18 to Marefair and then change to the free 20 bus to Sol Central.

Cycle CoNnect have bike hire docking stations at the park and ride, Waterside, St George's Avenue and Boughton Green Road Halls: as well as across the town, where you'll be able to rent a bike by the hour for your journey and dock it on arrival.
